## **BEACH/LAKE RULES**

## NORTHWOODS ASSOCIATION

The Forest Lake Beach is a private beach for Northwoods Association members and their families/guests. There is no public access for the lake. All members should be aware of the rules of the beach and should make their guests/renters aware of these rules to avoid any problems.

- 1. There is no lifeguard on duty and you swim at your own risk.
- All Association members should carry a beach pass when at the beach and any visitors/guests/renters should have a guest pass.
- 3. There should be no alcoholic beverages or glass containers on the beach.
- 4. No animals, leashed or unleashed, are allowed on the beach or the grassy picnic area adjacent to the beach. There is an area at the far end of the lake with a small beach area where dogs are allowed and can swim. Realize that all people are not dog/animal lovers and dogs can be a potential risk to sunbathers and especially children, who may have fear of dogs or not be knowledgeable about how to approach dogs. Members should be sure to inform any visitors/guests/renters of the policies regarding dogs on the beach.
- 5. No fireworks or weapons allowed on the beach.
- 6. No fishing on the boardwalk or on the beach.
- 7. If boats are left at the beach, they should be out of the water when not in use. The Northwoods Association is not responsible for theft or damage to property. Boats should have a Northwoods Association boat sticker for their boats.
- 8. No motor vehicles or bikes allowed on the beach.
- 9. No disruptive behavior allowed.
